ELIGIBILITY

2022-2023

Students are considered ineligible for athletic competition if they earn 2 D's or an F in their overall grades. Eligibility forms will go out to teachers on Tuesday. Reports of ineligibility will be sent to the Athletic Director by Thursday at 3:00. The Athletic Director will contact the coach. Coach will talk with the athlete. The Athlete has until the following Monday at 2:30 to improve grade(s) or make-up work. If the athlete does so and this is documented by the teacher, the athlete is eligible. If this does not occur the athlete is ineligible for the remainder of the week and until the grade improves and work is turned in.

Students must be present at school for at least half of the 7 hour school day in order to compete. If there are extenuating circumstances, please contact the Athletic Director Bill Kissell at 488-4776.

A student may also be deemed ineligible if his/her behavior is not in keeping with Lewis-Palmer Middle School expectations. The Principal/Assistant Principal/Dean will decide if a student becomes ineligible because of inappropriate actions. This can be determined at any time during the school week.

Exceptions to this would be if a student became ill or had an excused absence when work was due. The final determination for eligibility/ineligibility will be made by the Athletic Director.

Once a student is ineligible, he/she can practice with the team, but may not attend any competitions as part of the team for the remainder of the week (including Saturdays).

We strongly believe that in the "student-athlete", the student must come first. Students are encouraged to make sure they stay current with their assignments at all times.
