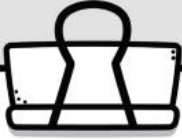

**ELA**(English Language Arts):  
**SPELLING TEST ON FRIDAY!**

**Phonics**—We will be working on “-ed and -ing endings”. In the area of phonics, we focus on different spellings for vowels, building automaticity and fluency when reading. **Reading**--Unit 4 “Different Perspectives, Different Points of View”—This week we will continue to focus on comparing and contrasting points of view, analyzing narrators points of view, and using metaphors. **Grammar/Writing**—Students will be working on using different parts of speech—nouns, verbs, adjectives, adverbs, and proper nouns. They will also be using a writer’s checklist to revise and edit their writing. This week they will write a letter to Santa.

**Math:** We will continue Unit 4—Measurement and Geometry. This week we will work on lines, rays, angles, triangles, and quadrangles. Keep working on Rocket Math at home.

**Social Studies:** We are continuing our U.S. Landmark project this week. We will research a landmark and complete a report using the information we found. This week in class, students will be working on their Google Slide for our classroom slide show. They will also be working on their Landmark Banner.
