

HSEA Program Highlights

The Lewis-Palmer Home School Enrichment Academy (HSEA) is a program designed to support families of homeschooled students in kindergarten through 8th grade.

Morning Meeting welcomes students and builds connections with each other. Through greetings, the pledge, games, jokes, birthday celebrations, announcements, etc., students develop relationships with their classmates that last throughout the year and beyond.

Children in **grades K-5** receive a full array of enrichment activities to include Music, Art, PE, Drama, and exploratory activities in science, literature, geography, and history.

- Art: paint, clay, watercolors, drawing, and more
- Music: basic instruments, rhythms, singing, play, and more
- PE: movement, teamwork, games, and more
- Drama: speaking, listening, acting, productions, and more

At the beginning of each semester, students in **grades 6-8** select from a “menu” of enrichment courses designed to supplement the home school curriculum. Our middle school team of teachers work hard to create a wide variety of fun and exciting courses each semester.
