FIRST DAY OF SCHOOL

Monday, August 19th

All students, except kindergarten, start on Monday, August 19th. Our kindergarten classes begin school on a staggered start schedule, with only half the students attending each day for the first 2 days. Parents of kindergarten students will receive a letter during the summer regarding their child's first day of school.

ASSESSMENT DAY:

Friday, August 30th

BACK TO SCHOOL NIGHT OPEN HOUSE:

Families can drop in anytime from 5:30 pm - 7:30 pm. Students should accompany their parents/guardians. This time is flexible and is designed to accommodate family schedules. Students will give their parents a tour of their classrooms and introduce them to the most important highlights of the year. And of course, our staff will be on hand for questions and guidance.

DELAYED START PLC (Professional Learning Community) WEDNESDAYS

For the 2019-2020 school year, LPES staff will be engaging in learning during a structured time called Delayed Start PLCs. All Lewis-Palmer schools have set aside this time for professional development. At Lewis-Palmer Elementary we will focus on how to improve our instruction to increase student achievement. There are five Wednesdays through the year that students will start at school at 10:55, instead of the normal 8:55 time. Buses will run 2 hours later than regularly scheduled times in the morning.
