

LPMS Transportation Reminders

Parents please keep in mind the following items as your student begins the school year at Lewis-Palmer Middle School.

- Our school office is staffed 7:00 a.m. until 3:30 p.m. Monday through Thursday and until 3:00 p.m. on Fridays. Students may enter the building at 6:55 a.m. and wait in the vestibule located in our front entrance. The inner doors will open at 7:00 a.m. and then students may proceed to their grade level waiting area. 8th graders will proceed to the cafeteria and the 7th graders will report to the small gym.
- First bell will ring at 7:16 a.m. Students will be dismissed from their waiting area and proceed to their lockers and their first period class. The late bell rings at 7:23 a.m. Students are dismissed at 2:34 p.m. daily. Buses leave our parking lot promptly at 2:39 p.m. Please carefully look at our drop-off and pick-up information.
- Students who are not participating in after school activities must leave the school grounds **after the school day**. We do not have a “late” bus for students participating in after-school activities. Many parents like to carpool and that may be an option for your family.

For 7th graders, we have worked in partnership with the YMCA to provide every 7th grader a free YMCA membership (you must sign up at the YMCA). This privilege is revocable if a student is not behaving in an acceptable manner either on the bus to the YMCA or in the facility itself. LPMS provides **one-way** transportation to the YMCA. A **LPMS transportation form** (located on our website under “Announcements” or available in our office) must be filled out in order for a student to ride the bus to the YMCA. If a student is travelling to the YMCA, it is their responsibility to sign up **each day** for the YMCA bus no later than 1:00pm. There will be no exception. We schedule our bus needs at **1:00pm daily** and use the reported number of riders for our seating needs.
