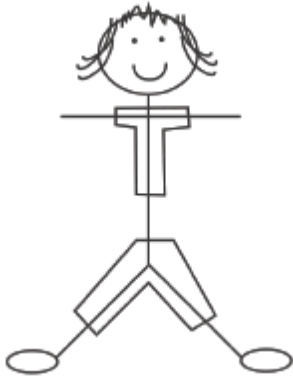
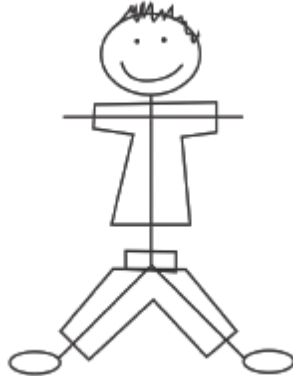


PRHS Dress Code Guidelines



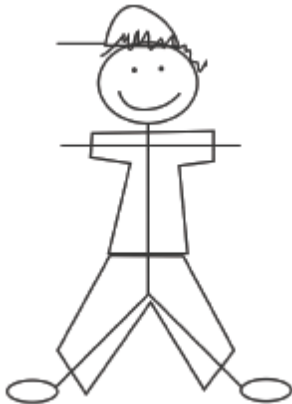
No bare midriffs!

Hemlines for skirts and shorts need to be at least mid-thigh.



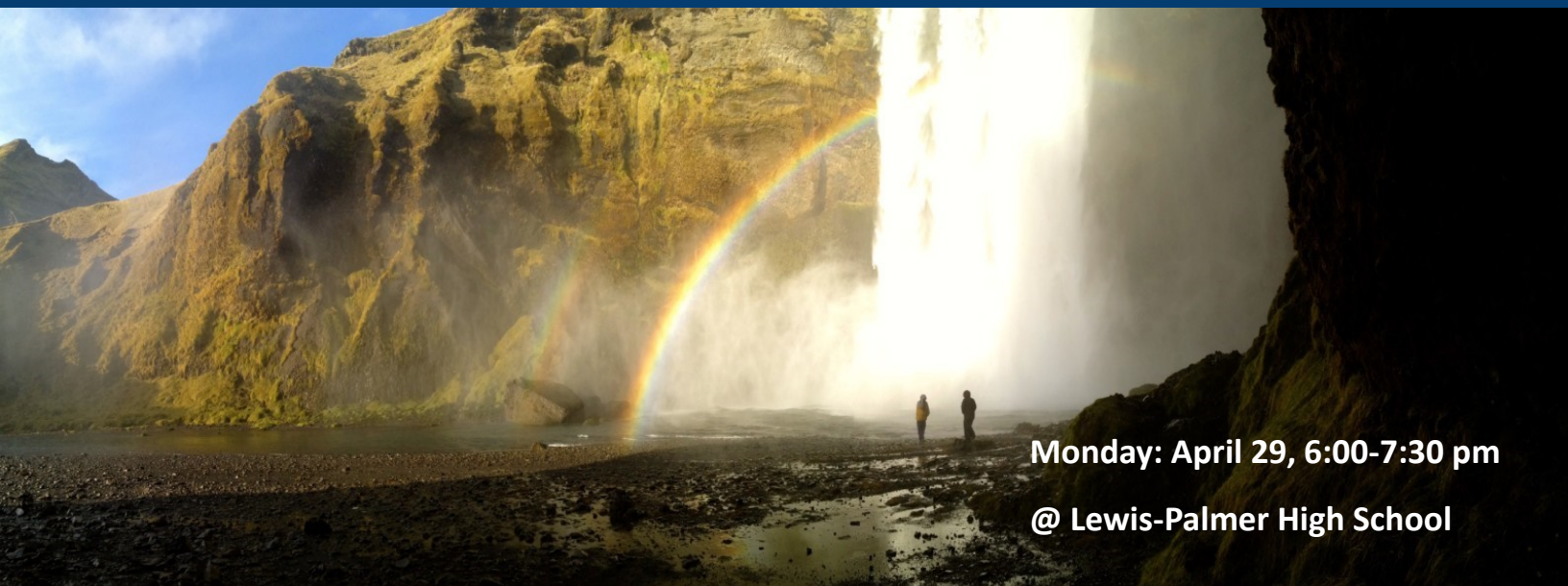
No inappropriate or offensive sayings or slogans on any visible clothing!
