Parent/Guardians of sophomore students,

The Class of 2021 graduation requirements contains a Personal Financial Literacy component. Students may meet this requirement and earn .5 credit by taking the semester long Personal Finance class during the junior year here at Palmer Ridge High School. Students may also complete 9 online modules through the EVERFI financial literacy program. We are requesting all sophomores in Study Hall or Free Range Bears complete the modules by Dec. 21st, 2018. A certificate of completion will be provided to the student and completion of the graduation requirement competency will be indicated in your students Infinite Campus profile.

Students received information about how to access these modules during Study Hall / Free Range Bears in early September and should be working towards completion by Dec. 21st, 2018. The EVERFI program is web-based and may be accessed at any time during Study Hall/ Free Range Bears or from home. Computer access in Study Hall/ Free Range Bears is limited, therefore it continues to be the students responsibility to ensure access to a computer in order to complete the modules. Students are permitted to bring their own computer to Study Hall/ Free Range Bears or use one of the three in the Study Hall classroom, or check out a computer in the library to compete these modules by Dec. 21st, 2018.
