SENIOR CLASS MEETING

We will have a **very important** senior class meeting on **Wednesday, April 1st** during the school day. ***It is very important that seniors attend!*** Seniors will report to class and an announcement will be made for dismissal to the auditorium. At this meeting we will distribute the **Educator Recognition Form** along with **Staff Herald Form**. We would like you to have your student think about who they would like to nominate for this special recognition and have them be prepared to fill out and return the forms at this class meeting. ***These will be tallied and those teachers selected by the class will be notified.*** Below is an explanation of each:

1. **EDUCATOR RECOGNITION NOMINATION FORM:** Seniors have an opportunity to nominate educators who made the greatest impact on their education in K-8th grades from the Lewis-Palmer School District 38. Top nominees will be honored guests at our graduation. They may nominate 2 at the elementary level and 2 at the middle school level.
2. **STAFF HERALDS:** Seniors may nominate two PRHS staff members to read each graduates name as they cross the stage at graduation.
