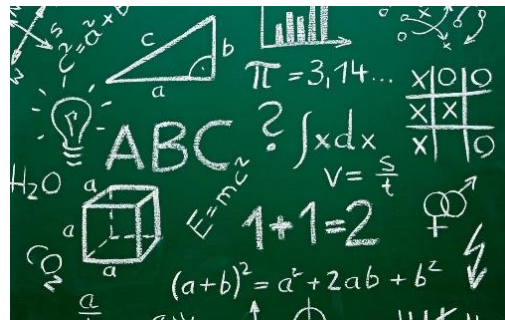


## MATH SUPPORT FOR PRHS STUDENTS

Struggling with math? Here is a list of opportunities for one-on-one help as well as online resources available to you! If you're not sure where to start, ask your math teacher ☺.



### FREE options:

- **Teacher assistance** - every PRHS teacher posts office hours (before/after school, plan periods) on their profile page, noting the times they are available to help students. Some teachers need advance notice, so please speak with your teacher about how to meet with them for one-on-one help.
- **AfterMath** - free math tutoring (by retired math teachers) at the Monument Library, on Mondays from 3:30 to 7:00 pm. Drop-ins are welcome!
- **Homework Group** - free assistance from PRHS teachers, held in the PRHS library on Tuesdays and Thursdays after school from 3:00 to 4:00 pm.
- **National Honor Society peer tutoring** - send an email to [prnhstutoring@lewispalmer.org](mailto:prnhstutoring@lewispalmer.org) to get connected with a junior or senior who can help you. Be sure to include your name, subject area of interest, and available times to meet.
- **Online Resources:**
