Student should login to google and their gmail using their firstname.lastname@lewispalmer.org and their super secret password.

REDO/CORRECTION POLICY:

As of January 2019, I have implemented a correction policy for any quiz or assignment. If a student scores a 69% (U) or lower on any assignment or quiz they may make corrections for credit. (a grade of 79-70% may also be corrected if you deem necessary) The corrections should be done on another piece of paper and stapled to the original assignment. Explaining their error is not necessary, HOWEVER they should work through the entire problem, show ALL their work and have the correct answer to receive credit.

Tests can always be corrected regardless of the grade earned. Test corrections are done on another piece of paper and should include the problem, their answer, the correct answer with all the work shown as well as an explanation of their error is part of their corrections.
