Band tutoring is an extracurricular program in which students in 6th, 7th, and 8th grade can work with high school students in the top bands of both high schools. It is a way for middle school students to:

- Improve on skills and techniques
- Learn more about their instrument and music from dedicated high schoolers
- Grow in music and meet new people!

Band Tutoring will run 4 times a semester from 5:30-7:00 on Monday nights at either Lewis-Palmer or Palmer Ridge High School. The schedule is:

2. Monday, September 30 @ Palmer Ridge 5:30-7:00
3. Monday, October 28 @ Lewis-Palmer 5:30-7:00
4. Monday, November 4 @ Palmer Ridge 5:30-7:00

Each session will be supervised by a different band director in the LPSD District: Mr. Eversole, Mr. Chapman, Mrs. Smith, and Mrs. Dunphey.
